RECLAIMING HOPE

The Problem:

There are more people being trafficked today than at any point in history.

Our Solution:

Reclaiming Hope journeys with survivors of sex trafficking to discover hope. We care for survivors at the point of recovery, during restoration and reintegration by addressing their physical, emotional and spiritual needs.

When a Survivor is recovered, their first connection with us comes through our Hope Bags. These are distributed through our law enforcement and



agencies at the point of recovery. Each Bag includes new clothing, hygiene items, a blanket, comfort items, snacks and a personal note. Over 6,000 Bags have given Survivors a sense of comfort and dignity.

We connect directly with Survivors through our Survivor Care Program. We offer practical help to women at each phase of their recovery. We match some of the women with trained, accountable mentors, and case management.

Growth:



The most obvious growth has been in our ministry space. We moved from 1,550 square feet to over 12,000! That's over 8 times. Every staff member finally has a desk, and their own office. As a result, we have had more Survivors visit our space than at any time in our previous history.


Each month, we host trafficking network groups: the El Paso County Human Trafficking Coalition, and the Southern Colorado Human Trafficking Task Force.
