Give praise for our volunteers who have helped us in so many ways, including sewing patches on Teddy Bears! We couldn’t run our Hope Bag program without such committed volunteers!	12. May God’s grace cover every memory and every place of fear for Survivors.	13. Pray for Mentors as they navigate relationships with their Mentees.	14. Pray that God will open doors to education, safe work, and healthy opportunities for every Survivor. That Hope will take root.
15. Pray for housing for our Mentees. For those with children, pray their children will grow in safety and dignity, build strong and healthy families.	16. Pray that trauma would not define a Survivors’ story, that they will discover their true identity and value. Silence every lie spoken over their life.	17. RH Team meeting Pray for the National Center for Missing & Exploited Children, for those who work the hotlines and for law enforcement to identify victims and dismantle networks.	18. Pray for organizations doing ethical, Survivor - centered work toward prevention, survivor care, and justice.	19. Pray that Survivors receiving our Hope Bags sense God’s presence and care. Pray that God continues to provide funding and gifts for our Hope Bag Program. The need is great and we are running low on many items.	20. Pray for staff and volunteers to stand strong against spiritual assaults, bold in spiritual warfare.	21. Pray that many will speak Truth to power when our legislators attempt to pass laws that will harm Survivors, rather than help them.
22. Pray for Survivors to have a voice in changing our culture: that fear will not silence their voice, they would feel in control of their story, and that sharing would empower, not retraumatize.	23. Pray for Human trafficking education, that myths about trafficking would be exposed, that awareness would grow, that our community will be strengthened and invested in fighting this evil.	24. Pray that churches and civic groups will prioritize prevention, Lawmakers will pursue survivor-centered policies, and schools will educate about exploitation.	25. Pray against systems and narratives that allow exploitation to thrive. Pray that we will build a culture that honors human dignity and protects the vulnerable.	26. Pray for everyone involved in RH to exemplify Christ. May all our hearts and actions do this as we journey together.	27. Pray that boundaries will be respected, for emotional safety, as Survivors boldly step out into the work environment. Surround them with wise advocates in the work setting.	28. Pray for continued safety for our staff and volunteers.
29. Pray that children will be shielded from exploitation; that grooming and coercion will be identified and exposed early; that safe adults would recognize warning signs.	30. Pray the technology would not become a doorway to exploitation and harm, especially for minors. Pray that digital platforms would strengthen safeguards.	31.
